

Working with Your Family Dentist

Your family dentist may have referred you to our office and naturally, he or she plays an important role in optimal oral health. We recognize the value of good communication between doctors and have therefore made a commitment to work with your family dentist to enable the most comprehensive treatment program. We regularly communicate with your family dentist during your treatment as well as during follow up.

About Orthodontics

Orthodontists specialize in the diagnosis, prevention and treatment of dental and facial irregularities, and treatment to achieve function, balance, and harmony between the teeth and face. Aside from the fact that crooked or crowded teeth can contribute to poor oral health, a beautiful smile can greatly enhance a person's self-esteem and self-confidence. Orthodontics can enhance one's quality of life at any age. There are several options for braces in varying degrees of visibility. We offer metal braces, gold braces, clear braces and the Invisalign® System.

The American Association of Orthodontists recommends that children should first visit an orthodontist no later than age 7. The primary advantage of early treatment is that a child's natural facial growth can be directed to avoid more costly and invasive procedures in the future.

No matter what your age, your appearance is an important aspect of your life. If you are unhappy with your smile, have crooked teeth or an uneven profile, it is never too late to begin orthodontic treatment.

Procedures and Services

Dr. Willett will personally explain all recommended procedures and will keep you fully informed about every aspect of your treatment. After gathering important information—which may include models, x-rays, and facial photographs—we can best determine your treatment plan.

Treatment time for braces can range from one to three years. During treatment, you should see your general dentist every six months for routine care. Our staff will also teach you how to take care of your teeth, gums and braces to help you maintain good dental health.

Scheduling

We understand your time is precious. Therefore, we have flexible office hours that allow you to make convenient appointments. We are also always available to answer questions or help our patients in an emergency situation.

Your First Appointment

When you first visit our office, we will give you a tour of the office before performing a comprehensive oral exam. If treatment is indicated, we will go over the recommended procedure in detail.

Insurance

Insurance coverage will be confirmed prior to your initial appointment to help you determine available benefits. Assignment of benefits is available in most cases, and we will bill your company as a courtesy to you. We will help in every way we can in filing your claim and handling insurance questions from our office on your behalf.

Financial Options

We offer three payment options (including a no-interest monthly payment plan) designed to suit different budgets. Cost of treatment is based on the severity of the patient's problem, as well as the quality of care patients receive in our office. This will be discussed at the consultation prior to initiating any treatment, thus making the most of the valuable time you have set aside from your busy schedule. There is no fee for the initial consultation.

Patient Protection and Comfort

Our office is committed to your safety.
